Ithaca Yacht Club Reciprocal Privileges

(IYC Bylaws Article 8 Section 2)

- a) The reciprocal privilege with the **Ithaca Country Club** allows 4 visits during the Spring/Summer season and 4 visits during the Fall/Winter season for the use of swimming, tennis and restaurant but not golf.
- b) At the request of a Regular Member, any Officer and/or Harbor Master may extend guest privileges of the Club to a visiting yachtsman who has a current membership in good standing of a yacht club that offers reciprocal privileges to the Ithaca Yacht Club. The visiting yachtsman must enter his or her name in the guest book provided for that purpose. A person shall not be a guest of the Club for more than five (5) days, nor more than once in six months, except that guest privileges may be extended to a maximum of thirty (30) days by consent of the Board of Directors.
- c) Yachtsmen who have a membership of other recognized yacht clubs extending reciprocal privileges shall be shown every courtesy in the way of moorings and the privileges of the Club, subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Club. Any Officer and/or Harbor Master of the Club may extend the privileges of the Club to visiting yachtsmen according to the letter sent to the club at the beginning of the season. A list of the reciprocal clubs shall be available to any Ithaca Yacht Club member upon request.
- d) The Officer and/or Harbor Master extending Club privileges shall furnish the visiting yachtsman with a card of invitation signed by the Officer. The card shall state the period of time for which it is valid.
- e) When accompanied by a Club member, a non-member may be entertained as a visitor of the Club for not more than four (4) days in any year. The name of every visitor to the Club shall be entered in the guest book kept for that purpose. It shall be the responsibility of the Club member accompanying such visitor to enter his name in the book.
- f) The privileges of guests and visitors may be withdrawn at any time by an Officer and/or Harbor Master of the Club.
- g) Members introducing guests and visitors shall be responsible for their conduct and for any debts incurred by them at the Club.
