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### **\* Procedures**

- Problematic, disruptive, or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated. Instructors will attempt to console students, but if after repeated attempts, a sailor remains disrespectful to his/her peers or the instructor staff, parents will be called and asked to pick up their child from the program.
- Maintaining a safe and positive environment is our first priority.
